We welcome Ayca, Can, Atilla, Shamy and Anandy to the beginners class. In the month of September, we will learn songs and read some favorite books: NO David,

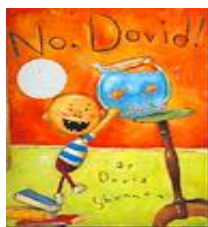
More Spaghetti I say,
